Parents and Siblings:

- Where were you born?
- Where were you raised?
- How many brothers and sisters do you have?
- What is/was your relationship like with your parents and siblings?
- Tell a story from your childhood or adolescence that gives insight into your family.

Spouse and Children:

- How many years have you been married?
- Have you ever been married before, and if so, for how long, and how long have you been separated or divorced?
- How many children, if any, do you have and what are their names and ages?

Vocation and Education:

- U Where did you go to school?
- What did you study or what do you now wish you had studied?
- Did you participate in any sports, music, etc in school?
- Where do you work and how do you spend your waking hours?
- If you could do anything but what you do now, what would it be?

Hobbies and Interests:

- U What do you enjoy doing in your spare time?
- If you suddenly inherited \$50,000 that you had to spend and you had one month to spend it, what would you do with the money and time?
- What have you never done that you wish you could do?

God and Church:

- What were you taught about God as a child?
- Describe how God pursued you/or is pursuing you now into a relationship with Him.
- Describe the state of your relationship with God now.
- What would you like your relationship with God to be like five years from now?
- Uhen you die and stand before God, what would you like for his first words to you to be?
