

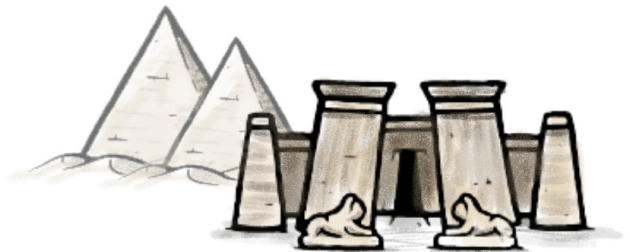
LIFEGROUP NOTES

THE GOD OF DELIVERANCE

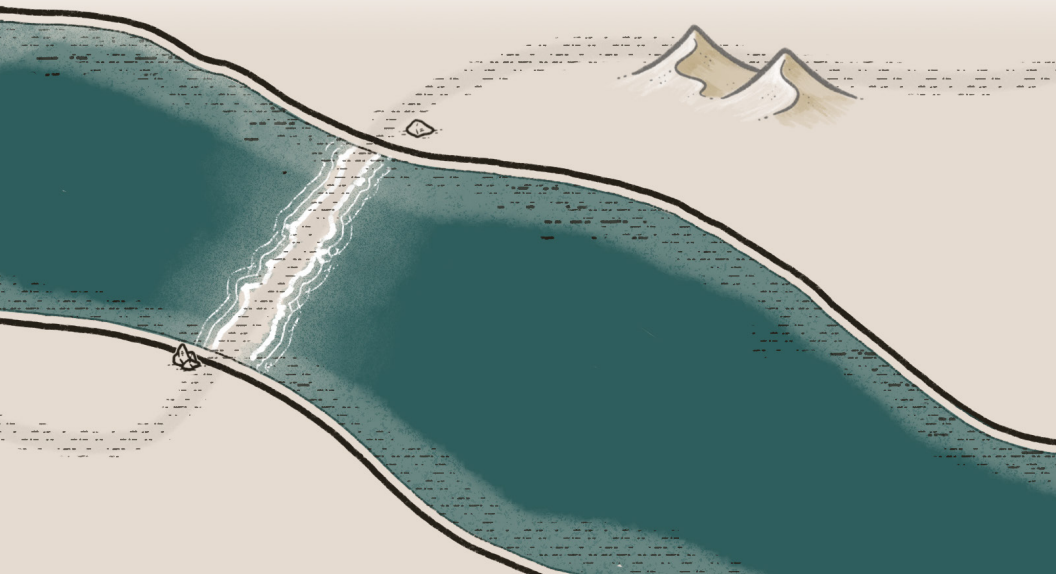
LIFEGROUP NOTES

THE GOD OF WORSHIP

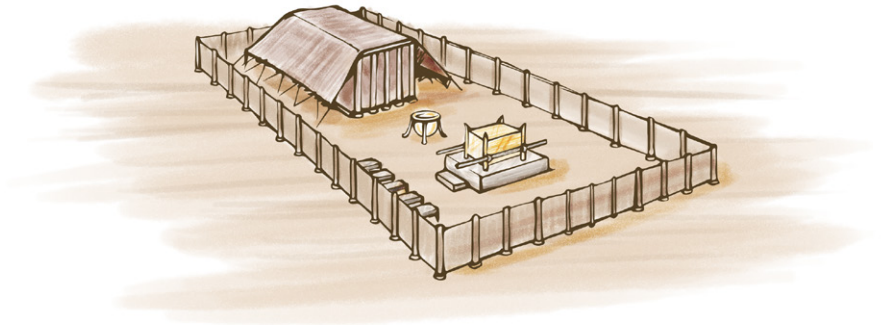
LIFEGROUP NOTES

THE GOD OF PROVISION

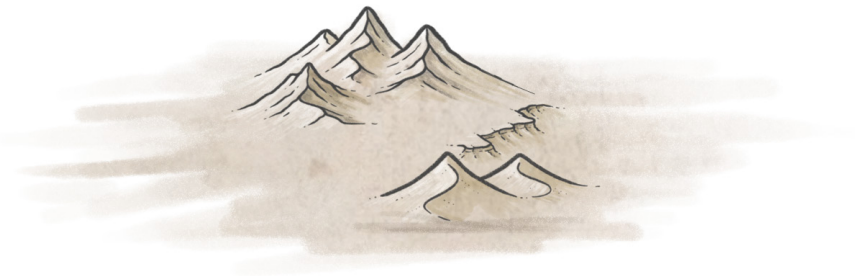
LIFEGROUP NOTES

4. From Exodus 17:7, Moses called the name of the place where he received water from a rock “Massah and Meribah”. What do these names mean and why do you think Moses used them? What can we learn and apply from this incident?
5. What have you learned about God from Exodus 16-17 that you previously did not know or realize?
6. What did you learn about the people of Israel and how are we often like them? How does God’s dealings with them encourage and challenge you?

THE GOD OF OUR FUTURE

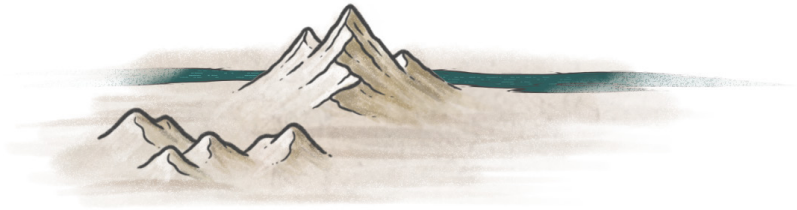
LIFEGROUP NOTES
